Derwent World Patents Legal Library

The Derwent World Patents Legal Library on Westlaw® provides detailed, current and comprehensive resources from Derwent Information, the world's leading patent and scientific information provider.

Updated every 3-5 days, the library references more than 20 million patents issued by 40 patent authorities. Each record is enhanced by Derwent's English-language abstracts. Also included are more than four million images and Derwent's classification codes and other tools for efficient, precise research.

The library tells you where in the world an invention is patented

The Derwent World Patents Legal Library organizes documents by patent family, including the basic patent, which ordinarily is the first patent issued on an invention, and subsequent or equivalent patents, which are issued by other authorities for the same invention.

The documents are well organized and complete. They include the patent numbers with document kind codes and publication dates, full filing details, the inventor and assignee details.

Derwent's more than 350 specialist editors add information to assist researchers in finding and understanding the patents. This includes:

- **Patent title** – A concise description, written in English, of the invention and its novelty.
- **Abstract** – A 250- to 500-word summary of the claims and disclosure of the invention.
- **Patent assignee code** – The owner of the invention, as indicated on the patent, is represented by a four-character code. Patents assigned to a parent company or its divisions, subsidiaries or affiliates can be retrieved via this single code, enabling simplified location of multinational businesses with various company names.
- **Class code** – Derwent's categorization of the invention and novelty. The classification system is simple and assists precise searching by clarifying ambiguous keywords, and by narrowing subject or keyword searches. There are 21 broad subject areas, subdivided into 291 well-defined classes.
- **Images** – Technical drawings selected as most representative of the invention's claims.
