Natural Language Searching

Westlaw retrieves documents according to how closely the concepts in your description match concepts in database documents. Retrieved documents are listed in order of how well the documents matched, with the best match listed first.

Table of Authorities

Briefs are integrated with the primary authority cited in the brief. Simply view the citation flags and click on the case link to view the cited authority.

Westlaw Integration

Briefs are integrated with supporting information and research features on Westlaw. Just click the hypertext link to display the information you want to view, such as cases, dockets, or other briefs. You can also research Profiler information, which describes the experience and background of participating attorneys, judges, and expert witnesses.
